Important Safety Instructions

Do not install near any heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other apparatus (including amplifiers) that produce heat.

Only use attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.

Unplug the apparatus during lightning storms or when unused for long periods of time.

Refer all servicing to qualified personnel. Servicing is required when the apparatus has been damaged in any way, such as power-supply cord or plug is damaged, objects have fallen into the apparatus, does not operate normally, or has been dropped.

Do not make unauthorized alterations to this product.

Do not use power inverter with this product.

Use this product only with the power supply provided.

Do not expose products containing batteries to excessive heat (eg. from storage in direct sunlight, fire or the like).

This equipment generates, uses, and can radiate radio frequency energy and, if not installed and used in accordance with the instructions, may cause harmful interference to radio communications. However, there is no guarantee that interference will not occur in a particular installation. Placement guidelines

For best 3G/4G connectivity performance, place the Beekee Hub in a location with the best 3G/4G reception.

Keep other wireless equipment at least 1 m (3 ft.) away from the Beekee Hub.

Avoid placing the Beekee Hub outside, or on wet or dirty surfaces.

For best connectivity performance, place your mobile device within 10 m (33 ft.) of the Beekee Hub, and make sure there is a clear line of sight between you and the Beekee Hub. Moving your device farther away, or not having a clear line of sight may impact connectivity, and your device may disconnect from the Beekee Hub.

Connecting to power

The Beekee Hub has an internal battery that withstand power cuts. However, it is important to leave it constantly connected to a power source.

1. Plug the USB-C cable into the USB-C connector on the Beekee Hub.
2. Plug the other end into the USB power supply.
3. Plug the USB power supply into an AC outlet.

Note

- If necessary, plug the AC adapter for your region into the AC outlet.

Powering ON/OFF the Beekee Hub

Short press the ON/OFF button of the Beekee Hub to turn it ON. Wait until the STATUS light turns steady green.

Long press the ON/OFF button of the Beekee Hub to turn it OFF.

- After a long time without being connected to a power source, the Beekee Hub may not turn ON. Leave it connected to a power source for an hour before trying again. If pressing the ON/OFF button does not turn the Beekee Hub ON, short press the RESET button.

Connecting to the Beekee Hub

On your device (smartphone, laptop, tablet), connect to the *BeekeeBox* WiFi network.

The default password is: *beekeebox*

Open a web browser (eg. Firefox) and go to *beekee.box*.

Notes

- Some device will warn you that this network has no Internet. Please tap on the option to stay connected.
- The Beekee Hub is not compatible with Internet Explorer and Opera Mini, please try with another browser.

Cleaning

To clean the Beekee Hub ventilation grid, disassemble them and clean them with water. Wait until the grid is dry before reassembling it.

Do not use any sprays near the Beekee Hub. Do not use any solvents, chemicals, or cleaning solutions containing alcohol, ammonia or abrasives.

Do not allow liquids to spill into any openings.
